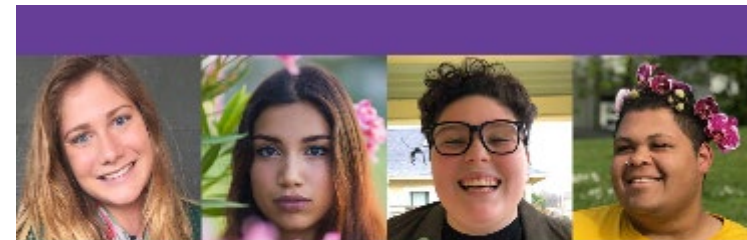

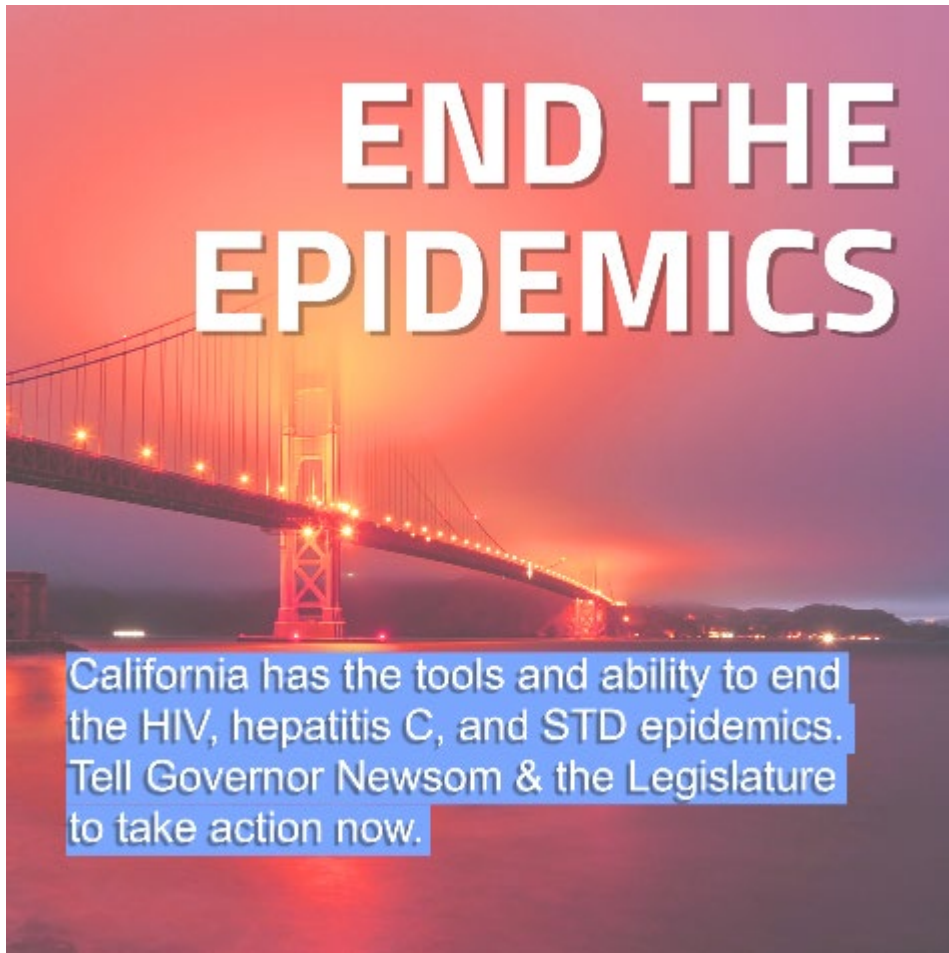
State Policy Updates

Lesbian, Bisexual, and Queer Women's Budget Proposal

- **\$6.5 million** for Demonstration Projects
- **\$3 million** for Localized Community Needs Assessments
- **\$3 million** for Training and Technical Assistance
- **\$3 million** for Community Education and Outreach
- **\$2 million** for Research
