Q How To Use Pronouns

- Q <u>ASK</u> people their pronouns when you meet them it's just as easy and important as asking for their name.
- Q <u>RESPECT</u> each person's right to use the pronouns that reflect who they are.
- Q <u>PRACTICE</u> using pronouns correctly, and if you make a mistake, correct it and move on. We're all human what matters is making it right.
- Q <u>UNDERSTAND</u> that pronouns are grammatically correct and essential to identity. Never assume someone's gender based on appearance.

It may feel awkward to use new pronouns at first, and mistakes are normal. Simply correct yourself or ask questions to get it right!
